

The long transport to Blackerpond

The coach made its way through Ungersponge, where the large disfigured monument of the tower block burnt to the ground with 537 casualties was much on display. The council had sold it off, but it is uncertain who it has been sold to. The fire brigade had to be sent 57 miles to douse the fire, and were ill-equipped to deal with the toxic after-effects of the cyanide emitting stair-well coverings. Unusually two firemen had died too.
